Courage Like Kate: The True Story of a Girl Lighthouse Keeper, by Anna Crowley Redding and Emily Sutton (4-8).

Twelve-year-old lighthouse keeper Kate Moore, who took over for his father when the lighthouse stairs became too difficult for him to navigate, saved 23 sailors in a storm off the Connecticut coast.

Nonfiction.

Hello, Lighthouse by Sophie Blackall (4-8).

Stunning illustrations sweep readers back in time to life in a lighthouse as the keeper weathers the seasons, grows his family, and eventually retires. **Fiction.**

Kate's Light: Kate Walker at Robbins Reef Lighthouse, by Elizabeth Spires and Emily Arnold McCully (4-8).

In a solitary and demanding existence, Kate Walker mended and managed a critical lighthouse in New York Harbor for more than three decades during the 19th century. **Nonfiction.**

Yukie's Island: My Family's World War II Story, by Yukie Kimura, Kōdo Kimura, and Steve Sheinkin, illus. by Kōdo Kimura (4-8).

A memoir of the author's childhood spent tending to a small island lighthouse in Japan, and the changes that 1945 brought her family. **Nonfiction.**

The Lighthouse Family series, by Cynthia Rylant, illus. by Preston McDaniels (6-9).

A gentle coastal adventure series in which a dog, a cat, and their three mice children explore the forest near their lighthouse home. **Fiction.**
