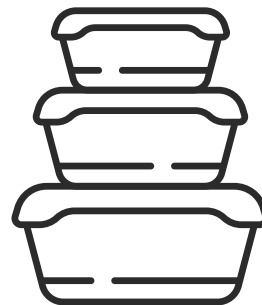

CRAFT: SUN CATCHERS

These easy to make sun catchers are a great craft for kids to add to their summer bucket list!

MATERIALS

- Container lids (yogurt, cottage cheese)
- Glue
- Food coloring
- Toothpicks
- A hole punch
- Yarn



WOW-TO

1. Carefully pour some glue into a container lid. You'll want to be sure to cover the bottom of the lid but there's no need to pour a thick layer (it will just take longer to dry).
2. Now add a drop or two of food coloring to the lid full of glue.
3. Using a toothpick, make designs by dragging the toothpick through the food coloring.
4. Wait for the glue to dry.
5. Once completely dry, carefully peel the sun catcher(s) out of the lids.
6. Using a hole punch, punch a hole in the sun catcher where you want to hang it from.
7. Thread a length of yarn through the hole and tie it into a loop to hang your sun catcher.
