Make Your Own Play Dough Soap

This stuff feels like Play Dough, but it's soap!

Materials:

- cornstarch
- liquid (Castille) soap, body wash or baby shampoo
- coconut oil
- food coloring
- essential oil

Wow To:

Step 1: Add a ½ cup of cornstarch and a ¼ cup liquid Castile soap to a medium sized bowl.

Step 2: Melt $\frac{1}{2}$ of a tablespoon of coconut oil, in the microwave for 20 seconds, and add to the same bowl.

Step 3: Add a few drops of food coloring and a few drops of essential oil to the bowl and mix everything together.

Step 4: Sprinkle some extra cornstarch on a flat clean work surface. Then dump the clumpy soap dough mixture on top of the cornstarch dusting and start kneading until it turns into a moldable dough. You can add more cornstarch if the mixture is too loose.

Step 5: Play Dough Soap can be used right away to wash hands and then the remainder should be stored in an airtight container when not in use. To use simply pinch off a small amount and use just like soap. It will fully dissolve and disappear with water.
