A rimmed baking sheet


Measuring cups

Oobleck! Make Up Your Mind!

AMAZING OOBLECK

It behaves like a solid or a liquid depending on the amount of pressure you apply. Grab some with your hand and it will form a solid ball in your palm until you release the pressure and then it flows out of your hand like a liquid.

Measure 1 1/2 cups of cornstarch and sprinkle it onto a sheet pan.

Add a cup of water to the sheetpan and mix with fork to combine. If you want to add some color, add the food coloring to the water before combining it with the cornstarch.

Add more water if too thick or more cornstarch if too soupy. You want it to separate when you drag a finger through it and then melt back together.

Squeeze it, squish it, scoop it, pinch it. Try to pick it up!
