**Apex Predators**, by Steve Jenkins (4-8).

With his signature cut-paper illustrations, a noted nonfiction writer explains how particular animals harness their speed, power, and savvy to dominate their surroundings. **Nonfiction.**

**Predator and Prey**, by DK Books (5-8).

An early readers look at the fight for survival between predators and prey. **Nonfiction.** Also available in this series: Shark: Apex Predator, and Animal Defenses.

**How to Promenade with a Python (and Not Get Eaten)(Polite Predators #1)**, by Rachel Poliquin and Kathryn Durst (6-9). First in a humorous series narrated by a clever cockroach (definitely a survivor) offering tips to surviving predator encounters. **Nonfiction.**

**Mega Predators of the Past**, by Melissa Stewart and Howard Gray (6-9). Sure, the T-Rex was a menace, but many of today's predators had ancestors equally threatening to their ecosystems. Illustrated by a former zoologist. **Nonfiction.**

**Tracking Pythons: The Quest to Catch an Invasive Predator and Save an Ecosystem**, by Kate Messner (8+). Burmese pythons are devastating the South Florida ecosystem; this photo-filled field guide follows scientists tracking the invasive predators in an attempt at ecological mitigation. **Nonfiction.**

**Ultimate Predatorpedia: The Most Complete Predator Reference Ever**, by Christina Wilsdon (8+). A full-color, fact-filled guide to the remarkable predators both extinct and still roaming Earth. **Nonfiction.**
