<u>Toilet: How It Works</u>, by David Macaulay (5-8). Clear language and detailed illustrations explain the process between a flush and waste reaching the water treatment plant. **Nonfiction**.

The Great Stink: How Joseph Bazalgette Solved London's Poop Pollution Problem, by Colleen Paeff & Nancy Carpenter (5-8). An innovative 19th century engineer saved lives – and seriously reduced smells – by orchestrating an elaborate underground system to remove human waste from London's city center. Nonfiction.

The Big Flush (Area 51 Files #3), by Julie Buxbaum (8-12). A killer space toilet hurtling towards Earth threatens Sky and her alien friends living in Area 51. Fiction.
