WOW TO:

- 1 Safety first-** be sure to include a grown-up in your planning!

- 2 Choose a location-** think about places you frequently pass day-by-day that might benefit from a good cleanup. Make sure it's safe and accessible.

- 3 Decide who is joining you** and pick a day and time that works for all.

- 4 Create a checklist!** A good scavenger hunt needs a list of treasures (or trash in this case) to hunt for. List out all of the different kinds of trash you might find (eg: cans, bottles, food wrappers, paper, etc.).

- 5 Gather all of your supplies** so you are ready on the day of the hunt.

- 6 When the day arrives-** get outside and start hunting, errr cleaning.
