<u>Sea Without a Shore: Life in the Sargasso</u>, by Barb Rosenstock & Katherine Roy (5+). A single blade of sargasso seaweed hosts an entire ecosystem of marine life; meticulously researched and gorgeously illustrated. **Nonfiction**.

<u>Mindy Kim and the Yummy Seaweed Business</u>, by Lyla Lee (5-9). Mindy's first day of school snack of dried seaweed leads to a business that helps her raise funds for a puppy. **Fiction**.
