(Soundbite of thumb drive coming down tube.)

Carly. Literally. A new time-sealed event shot out of the delivery tube and hit me square in the nose. Literally? Let's see what you're about.

Audio file. (Beep) The Yeti (Beep) Eric Shipton (Beep) Himalayas beep 951.

Carly. Yeti? Like the water bottle? Let's see, Yeti, Eric Shipton, Himalayas, 1951. After consulting with H-Dad I learned that the Yeti was a mythical ape-like creature that lived in the snowy Himalayan mountains.

Carly in the background. Oh, like the Abominable Snowman!

(Soundbite of wind chimes.)

Odie. Lewis! You can't just come charging down here demanding pie!

Carly. Don't worry, the pie is safely behind glass, ready to go. But first I have to make a super quick, teeny little trip to the Himalayas.

Lewis. What?!

Carly. Why do you think we're going through all this lost and found? We gotta find something warm.

Lewis. The elevator has a lost and found?

Carly. Yeah, check it out ...(rummaging through). Suit of armor, a puffy pirate shirt, bucket hat ...

Lewis. And why are you going to the Himalalayas? Huh, feels like I added an extra "La".

Odie. You did.

Carly. To find the Yeti! You know; the big, hairy, snow ape that lives in the mountains.

Carly. (called out)Over here.

Lewis. (called out) I can't see a thing!

Carly. (called out) Yeah, this snow storm's pretty bad.

Lewis. How are we going to find anything in this weather?

Carly. I dunno, maybe someone will find us?

Lewis. In the middle of the Himalalayan mountains?

Carly. Too many "Las!"

Reginald. . Hello there!

Carly. Yeti!

Reginald. (chuckles) No, my name is Reginald Bailey. I've been sent to collect you.

Lewis. You've been sent to collect us?

Reginald. Indeed! You are the two research assistants from Kathmandu, are you not?

Carly. Of course! Who else would we be?

Reginald. Excellent! Mr Shipton is waiting for you in camp .It's right this way, follow me!

(Soundbite of walking through snow.)

Carly. Look, Lewis! Tents!

Lewis. Looks like we were actually quite close after all.

Reginald. Mr. Shipton is right through here in the Mess tent.

(Soundbite of Carly entering a tent.)

Reginald. Excuse me Sir.

Eric. Yes, Reggie, what is it?

Reginald. Those two researchers from Kathmandu have arrived.

Eric. Ah! Excellent. Names?

Carly.Carly Q

Lewis. Lewis

Eric. Pleasure to meet you both. I suppose you're here about the photo.

Carly. The photo?

Eric. Of the Yeti footprint.

Carly. Yeti Footprint!

Eric. Precisely!

(Soundbite of photo being slammed on table.)

Carly. Woooaaahhh.

Lewis. What is that?

Eric. That, Mr Lewis, is a sizable footprint in the snow no less than Twenty thousand feet above sea-level.

Carly. Or should you say SNOW level? Huh? Tough crowd.

Lewis. Who in their right mind would go out in the snow barefoot!

Eric. Not who, but what!

Carly. You don't think it could be.

Eric. For centuries the natives have spoken of a ten foot tall beast, covered in fur, with the dimensions and gait of a giant man.

Lewis. And you think this creature left its footprint in the snow?

Eric. That, is the million pound question and the reason you and your colleague have been brought out here. To investigate this Yeti footprint.

Carly. Boo yah Baby!

Carly. Business?

(Soundbite of walking through snow.)

Lewis. (called out). What's exciting is the idea of getting into some warmer clothing!

Carly. Whoa, I do love an equipment tent.

Reginald. Let's see, we have hiking pants here, thermal jackets are here and boots and headwear are stored and-

(Soundbite of murmuring outside.)

Carly. Ohh look at me this jacket is so fluffy.

Lewis. Carly?

Carly. Huh?

Lewis. Those must be the real researchers our cover is blown!

Carly. Lewis, don't get your scrunchies in a bundle. It could be anyone out there

Lewis. At 20,000 feet?

Carly. Yeah, people love going for hikes these days. Those days. Any days really.

(Soundbite of a huge roar is heard outside the tent.)

Lewis. What was that?!

Carly. Uh, the wind?

Lewis. That was definitely not the wind!

(Soundbite of a roar.)

Carly. The Yeti!

Lewis. The Yeti!

(Soundbite of Carly and Lewis running outside.)

Lewis. This I gotta see.

Carly.Me first!

Lewis. Carly! Stop pushing!

Carly. I gotta get out of the tent!

(Soundbite of Carly and Lewis struggling with each other before falling out the tent and into a pile.)

Mindy. Uh Hello?

Carly. Hi! Carly Q, nice to meet ya.

Mindy. Hi there Carly ! I'm Mindy.

Guy. And I'm Guy Raz.

Mindy. Oooh, nice revolutionary war costumes.

Guy. Seems like an unusual choice for the Himalayas in 1952.

Lewis. Says the man in the space suit.

Guy. Uh, fair enough.

Mindy. Wait, are you two traveling through time too?!

Carly. We are!

Lewis. Carly Q! We're reaaaaaly not meant to talk about that.

(Soundbite of a roar.)

(Soundbite of a roar.)

Lewis. That thing must be 10ft tall!

Guy. And it's getting on all fours and heading straight for us!

Mindy. Ruuuuun!

Carly. Ruuuuuuuun!

(Soundbite of a roar then Mindy, Guy, Carly and Lewis all run away.)

Mindy. (while running) Don't worry everyone I have the Wow Machine parked right around the corner!

Carly. (Out of breath) You have a Wow Machine? That's incredible! A Wow Machine! (beat) What is a wow machine?

Mindy. You're gonna love it.

Guy. Mindy! Quick open the hatch

(Soundbite of Mindy opening the Wow Machine.)

Mindy. Opening, opening, opening!

Guy. Mindy! Quick!

(Soundbite of Wow Machine opening.)

Mindy. Quick! Everyone inside!

Lewis. (whispering) Everyone ... stay very ... very ... quiet.

Mindy. (yelling) What?! Can't hear you! You gotta talk louder!

Guy. (whisper yelling) Mindy! shhhhhh!

(Soundbite of the beast sniffs around the door.)

Guy. Mindy! What was that thing?!

Mindy. Guy Raz I told you! It was a yeti!

(Soundbite of H-dad dinging.)

H-dad. H-Dad, powering on!

Mindy. Gah! What was that?

Carly. Oh, that's just my H-dad. Sorry. I thought I put this thing on silent.

H-dad. New information found on local wildlife, animal emoji, running emoji, scared face emoji.

Carly. Local wildlife?

Lewis. Maybe it can tell us what just chased us out of that camp.

Carly. Well we already know what that Lewis. It was a Yeti.

Lewis. Just ask H-dad.

Carly. UGH Fine! (clears throat) H-dad, what creature almost ate me and my new friends?

(Soundbite of snow winds.)

Lewis. It's all fun and games until you get a demeriiiiiiiii!
