DIY CAMPAIGN POSTERS

If you were running for president, what in the WOW would you stand for??? This activity sparks creativity and explores what goes into the voting process. Ideal for mock elections or social studies lessons.

1 Imagine you are running for president of your class, your grade, or the entire school. Think about how you might get others to vote for you. Candidates run for election based on a platform, or list of ideas and beliefs. This platform helps voters decide if they want to vote for you or not.

2 Brainstorm what your platform will be:

- ★ Less homework! ★ Longer recess! ★ Bringing back chocolate milk!

3 Write a brief statement for each of your ideas or campaign promises that explains why this change would be beneficial to your voters.

4 Next you will create a slogan for your poster. It can be as simple as "Vote for Mindy!" or something fun like "Guy's your guy!". Keep it short and memorable! You can search online for inspiration if needed.

5 Time to take out the decorative papers, scissors, glue and poster board! Make sure your poster has your **name** and **campaign slogan** clearly written on it. You'll share the **campaign promises** with potential voters as you meet them!
