Producer: <<In the booth>> Okay, Mindy..Guy Raz...Welcome to Planet Earth, take one. You ready?

Mindy: Ready!

Guy Raz: Let's do it!

Producer: Okay, Reggie...

Reggie: Coo

Producer: Cue music. Annnnd action!

<<Scene opens to light harp music and nature sounds>>

Mindy: Looking to settle down and make a home somewhere in the Milky Way Galaxy? Well then look no further than planet Earth. The universe's premier destination for comfort, adventure, and bonkerballs natural beauty.

Guy Raz: Nestled in the heart of the Goldilock's Zone, our four and a half billion year old planet is never too hot and never too cold... In fact, it was designed with a special invisible blanket of heat-trapping gasses to always keep our temperatures just right.

Guy Raz: No no, Mindy has a point here! Planet Earth is not only the best home for all living things including us but it's also the only home we've got.

Mindy: And in order for our planet to take care of us, we've got to take care of our planet.

Gramma G-Force: Well how we supposed to do that, Mindy!?

Thomas Fingerling: Yeah!

Mindy: Well, there are all sorts of things we can do to stop polluting our atmosphere, starting in our own homes!

Thomas Fingerling: Oh, like what?

Guy Raz: Well for starters, we can reuse things instead of buying them new.
